Item Summary:

Staff advertised a Request for Proposals for Grant Administration Services in The Facts newspaper on Saturday, October 22, and Saturday, October 29, 2022. Six responses were received by 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The proposals were reviewed by the City Manager, Assistant City Manager/Director of Public Works, and Finance Director. Based on the Evaluation Criteria, the most qualified Respondent is GrantWorks, Inc.

Background Information:

These services are being solicited to assist the City of Freeport in its application and administration of contracts, if awarded, from the General Land Office (GLO) Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation Regional Method of Distribution (CDBG-MIT MOD) Program through HGAC.

These services will include assistance through the application and grant administration process. The City has been awarded \$1,837,967 in grant funds.

Item Summary:

Staff advertised a Request for Statement of Qualifications for professional engineering services in The Facts newspaper on Saturday, October 22, 2022 and Saturday October 29. 2022. Four responses were received by 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The evaluation committee consists of the City Manager, Assistant City Manager/Director of Public Works and Director of Human Resources and Finance Director.

Background Information:

The City of Freeport an application for a project for the General Land Office (GLO) Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation Regional Method of Distribution (CDBG-MIT MOD) Program through HGAC. Accordingly, the City must procure a contract with a qualified Engineering firm or individual to prepare all preliminary and final design plans and specifications, and to conduct all necessary interim and final inspections. These services are being solicited to assist the City in its application preparation and project implementation. The application is due January 9, 2023.

Financial Impact:

Engineering and design activities are capped at 15 percent of the total construction cost and will be funded by the grant.
