COUNCIL REGULAR AGENDA

Consideration and possible action on Ordinance 2023-2703, amending the direction of traffic on McNeal Street and Karankawa Street in the City of Freeport.

Mr. Kelty explained what this ordinance would change. He said the ISD requested making Karankawa and McNeal Streets a two-way street during the hours of 7:15 a.m.-8:30 a.m., and 2:30 p.m.-3:30 p.m. He said this will help accommodate the drop off and pick up hours at the school.


A motion was made by Councilman Matamoros to approve Ordinance 2023-2703, amending the direction of traffic on McNeal Street and Karankawa Street in the City of Freeport, with discussion that followed.

There was discussion by Councilman Matamoros about, Ave C & D intersecting McNeal, Ave B and McNeal, he asked about the two exits of 5th and 6th Streets. Ms. Cundieff said there will be staff out helping with the direction of traffic. Mr. Kelty said one-way signs will be removed tomorrow.

Mayor Bass called the motion to a vote, with all present voting "Aye" 4-0 council unanimously approved Ordinance 2023-2703, amending the direction of traffic on McNeal Street and Karankawa Street in the City of Freeport.
