# ordinance no. <u>2009-22</u>32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, BRAZORIA COUNTY, TEXAS, CONTAINING A PREAMBLE; CONTAINING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF SAID CITY BY REPEALING ITEM (10) OF DIVISION (1) OF SECTION 155.023 THEREOF; RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING ALL ACTIONS PREVIOUSLY TAKEN BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF SAID CITY OR THE CITY COUNCIL, OR BOTH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; CONTAINING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Freeport, Texas, is a "Home Rule City" and a "Home Rule Municipality" lying and situated in Brazoria County, Texas, as described in and defined by Section 5, Article XI of the Constitution of Texas and Section 1.005 of the Local Government Code of Texas, respectively; and,

WHEREAS, Subchapter A of Chapter 211 of the Local Government Code of Texas and Item (g) of Section 3.07 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Freeport authorizes the City Council thereof to adopt the provisions of this Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Freeport has determined to here now declare that the adoption of this ordinance is necessary to the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of said City and is necessary to conform the comprehensive zoning plan of said City to the current zoning conditions which exist therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE -- Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

The City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law, viz:

First, that the public hearings required by the Zoning Enabling Act of the State of Texas, codified as Chapter 211 of the Texas Local Government Code, and the present Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Freeport, Texas, codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinances of the City, have been conducted in the manner and at the time required.

Second, that not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of such hearings, public notice thereof was published once in the Brazosport Facts, a newspaper of general circulation in and the official newspaper of said City, stating the date, time and place of such hearings.

Third, that after considering evidence submitted at such hearings, the City Council of the City of Freeport is of the opinion and finds that the change in the comprehensive zoning ordinance of said City set forth below is necessary to conform the comprehensive zoning plan of said City to the current zoning conditions which exist therein.

Fourth, that the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Freeport, Texas, will best be served by the adoption of this ordinance.

#### SECTION TWO--Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Amended

The Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Freeport, Texas, read, passed and approved as Ordinance No. 1100 on the 3rd day of April, 1964, now codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinances thereof and hereinafter called "the Zoning Ordinance," is hereby amended by repealing Item (10), Division (I) of Section 155.023 of the Code of Ordinances of said City and the paving requirements contained therein.

# SECTION THREE--Ratification and Confirmation.

The City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, hereby ratifies and confirms any and all action taken by the Planning Commission of said City or the City Council of said City, or both, in connection with the change in zoning classification evidenced by this ordinance, including but not limited to the calling of a public hearing required by said Zoning Enabling Act and the Zoning Ordinance, the giving of public notice of such hearings, the giving of written notice to the owners of property which is the subject of such and to the adjoining property owners, the making of preliminary and final reports with respect to such change and the conducting of the public hearings required by said Act and the Zoning Ordinance.

#### SECTION FOUR--Savings Clause

No offense committed and no fine, forfeiture or penalty incurred prior to the effective date of this ordinance is to be affected by the adoption of this ordinance but the punishment for any offense committed and the recovery of any fines or forfeitures incurred prior to such date shall take place as if this ordinance had not been adopted.

# SECTION FIVE -- Severance Clause.

In the event any section or provision of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, void or inoperative by the final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such defective provision, if any, is hereby declared to be severable from the remaining sections and provisions of this ordinance and such remaining sections and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

# SECTION SIX--Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the descriptive caption of this ordinance has been published twice in the Brazosport Facts.



# RESOLUTION NO. 2009-2216

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS, CONTAINING A PREAMBLE; DIRECTING THAT THE CITY, THROUGH ITS CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, PURSUE ALL ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANTS (EECBG) PROGRAM FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) OF 2009 AND BEING ALLOCATED BY THE STATE ENERGY CONSERVATION OFFICE; CONTAINING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORIGINAL OF THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE MAINTAINED BY THE CITY SECRETARY IN THE PERMANENT RECORDS OF SAID CITY.

Whereas, the City of Freeport, Texas, hereinafter sometimes "the City," is a "Home Rule City" and a "Home Rule Municipality" lying and situated in Brazoria County, Texas, as described in and defined by Section 5, Article XI of the Constitution of Texas and Section 1.005 of the Local Government Code of Texas, respectively, with a Home Rule Charter that designates its City Manager as its chief executive officer; and,

Whereas, Congress passed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 and the President signed into law on February 17th, 2009, to stimulate the economy and create jobs; and,

Whereas, ARRA included \$3.2 billion in funding for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants (EECBG) Program authorized in Title V, Subtitle E of the Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA) and signed into law on December 19, 2007; and.

Whereas, the purpose of the EECBG program is to, 1) reduce fossil fuel emissions in a manner that is environmentally sustainable, and to the maximum extent practicable, maximizes benefits for local and regional communities; 2) to reduce the total energy use of eligible entities; and, 3) to improve the energy efficiency in the building sector, the transportation sector and other appropriate sectors; and,

Whereas, the City is a city with limited financial resources and desires to support the development of energy efficiency programs; and,

Whereas, the City desires to accept its allocation and may also accept additional funds that may become available at a later date; and,

Whereas, the City has developed or is interested in developing a EECBG project, which is sustainable and has measurable energy savings, job creation and economic stimulus effects into the City; and,

Whereas; the City is determined to support energy efficiency projects that leverage federal funds with other public and private resources, including coordinated efforts involving other Federal programs targeting community development; and,

Whereas, the City intends to comply with all agreed upon contractual requirements of ARRA, the EECBG program and other federal and state law; and,

Whereas, the City Council of the City has determined and do here now declare that the adoption of this resolution is necessary to the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of and the conservation of energy within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS:

First, that the facts stated in the preamble of this resolution are found to be true.

Second, that the City, through it City Manager, or his designee, pursue all EECBG funding made available through ARRA and being allocated by the State Energy Conservation Office to be used to assist in reaching the city's goals of energy efficiency.

Third, that the City continue its commitment toward energy efficiency for the citizens of the City and all of Texas.

Fourth, that in the event any section or provision of this resolution is found to be unconstitutional, void or inoperative by the final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such defective provision, if any, is hereby declared to be severable from the remaining sections and provisions of this ordinance and such remaining sections and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Fifth, that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption.

Sixth, the original of this resolution, after execution and attestation, shall be maintained by the City Secretary in the permanent records of the City.

Dear Mayor McDonald:

I am pleased to inform you that the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) is providing more than \$45 million to the State Energy Conservation Office (SECO), a part of the Comptroller's office, for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) program. This money will be available to small cities and counties that did not receive a direct allocation from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) under this program.

In an effort to ensure that the 1,127 cities and 244 counties in Texas that are not receiving direct dollars from DOE are able to benefit from this funding, the money will be redistributed based on a population formula. As a result, it is currently anticipated that your city/county may be eligible for \$50,000.

The EECBG program, authorized in Title V, Subtitle E of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 and signed into Public Law (PL 110-140) on Dec. 19, 2007, will be funded for the first time under ARRA. The purpose of the program is to provide funds to units of local and state government, Indian tribes and territories to develop and implement projects to improve energy efficiency and reduce energy use and fossil fuel emissions in their communities. At the federal level, the program is administered by the Office of Weatherization and Intergovernmental Programs in the Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy of DOE.

A comprehensive list of the 1,127 cities and 244 counties that are eligible for these funds can be found on our Web site at www.seco.cpa.state.tx.us/arra/eecbg/index.php. In the event that there are eligible communities that chose not to accept the funds, we will reallocate those dollars to the participating cities and counties. Your final potential grant will be outlined in a letter that will arrive when the application is sent to you.
