Call meeting to order.

Vice Chairman Tobey Davenport called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Consideration of the approval of the November 24th, 2009 minutes.

Mr. Pirrung had a concern with the date on Section 1.02 Boundaries not being consistent with the map that is presently on file at City Hall. City Secretary Delia Munoz produced Ordinance Number 1022 describing the full metes and bounds description of the City of Freeport as it existed, dated April 25th, 1960.

Consultation with City Attorney on proposed amendments for the Home Rule Charter 2009-2010.

Mr. Shaw was asked to draft the propose changes and the Commission will present their recommendation to council as a final report.
