DREDGING:

Mike Sorrell is waiting for City documents giving him authorization to begin the dredging. Probably a PO#. I told him he was low bid and would be awarded the contract. He said he had read that in the paper, but no one from the City has contacted him yet. (Nat said it will be sent this weekend to them)
