Call to order.

Chairman Edward T. Garcia called the meeting to order at 6:13 p.m.

Conduct a Joint Public Hearing to consider a proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of map of said City codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinance of said City, changing the zoning classification of Lots 13-24, Block 600 and Lots 1-12, Block 601, Velasco Townsite, City of Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, from its present classification of R-2 Single-family Residential District to a new classification of C-2 General Commercial District.

There being a quorum with the Planning Commission and City Council, Chairman Edward T. Garcia opened the Joint Public Hearing at 6:13 p.m. to consider changing the zoning classification of Lots 13-24, Block 600 and Lots 1-12, Block 601, Velasco Townsite, City of Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, from its present classification of R-2 Single-family Residential District to a new classification of C-2 General Commercial District. He asked for comments or questions from the audience on the proposed zoning classification.

Jesse Flores of 610 North Ave. G, turned in a petition with 18 residential names and signatures of people that oppose the rezoning.

Debbie Gibson, David Gibson and Dina Mochie opposed the rezoning. She stated that Velasco Elementary and Lanier School would have children crossing the propose RV to get to their homes.

Debra Timberess opposed the rezoning.

Monica Kneis of 606 N. Ave. G, opposed the rezoning. She stated that the City is always trying to beautify and rezoning would allow an RV to have infestations', critters and trash. She felt it would be a mole in a beautiful City. She suggested the rezoning take place in another location.

Manning Rollerson stated not to judge people where they live and favors the rezoning change.

Nicolosa Mireles of 2002 North Ave. G, favors the rezoning. She lives next door to a trailer park and stated that an RV benefits all businesses.

There being no comments or question, Chair Edward T. Garcia closed the Joint Public Hearing at 6: 40 p.m. Mayor Norma Garcia thanked the Planning commission.

Make a recommendation to the City Council concerning whether or not the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and Map of said City, codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinances of said City should be amended to change the zoning classification of Lots 13-24, Block 600 and Lots 1-12, Block 601, Velasco Townsite, City of Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, from its present classification of R-2 Single-Family District to a new classification of C-2 General Commercial District.

On a motion by Edward T. Garcia, seconded by Eddie Virgil, with all present voting "aye", the Planning Commission denied changing the zoning classification of Lots 13-24, Block 600 and Lots 1-12, Block 601, Velasco Townsite, City of Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, from its present classification of R-2 Single-Family District to a new classification of C-2 General Commercial District. Jesse Aguilar abstained from voting.
