MINUTES

The Board of Commissioners of the Urban Renewal Agency of Freeport, Texas, was called to order at 6:00 o'clock P.M. by the Director, Nat Hickey, with Commissioners Shultz, Sanford, Gonzales and Leavey present, constituting a quorum to conduct business.

Gilbert Arise representing the City of Freeport was present.

The Director recognized those present and advised the purpose of the meeting was to consider amending the Urban Renewal Project to establish a greenbelt buffer zone in the project area in the Velasco Townsite between industry and residential, and to transfer the recommended properties to the Freeport Economic Development Corporation for development.

The Urban Renewal Board recommend to the Freeport City Council that the Urban Renewal Project be amended to include the establishment of a greenbelt buffer zone between industrial and residential in the Velasco Townsite Urban Renewal area, and that the project be referred to the Freeport Economic Development Corporation for development.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn, with those present voting Aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
