

Public Notice to Boil Water

October 30, 2024

Due to a condition (WaterLine Break) which occurred on October 30, in the water system in the City of Freeport, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system (City of Freeport TX0200005) to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, brushing teeth, cooking and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
