DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND FEMA- INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE

The City of Freeport has authorized FEMA to utilize the Freeport Recreation Center for individual assistance from Hurricane Beryl beginning August 7, 2024, for a soft opening at 1:00 p.m. and will continue normal operations on August 8, 2024. Hurricane Beryl unfortunately damaged most of the City's buildings which limits the use of our facilities currently. The Freeport Recreation Center is the only facility available to host FEMA currently and the decision was made to host the FEMA individual assistance program for the residents of Freeport. FEMA will be providing services to our residents for Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) for individual assistance providing information such as status of applications and general information on FEMA disaster assistance along with other Federal, State, Local and voluntary organizations providing similar information on their programs. Normal operating hours will be 8a.m -6 p.m., Monday – Saturday located at 803 N. Front Street, Freeport TX. 77541. The Freeport Recreation Center will be closed until September 30, 2024, during this event. We apologize for the inconvenience.
